



Marvell Policy Statement on the Responsible Sourcing of Minerals

Marvell Technology, Inc. (“Marvell”) supports the responsible sourcing of tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold, cobalt, copper, graphite, lithium, mica, and nickel in accordance with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (“OECD Guidance”) and its model supply chain policy.

Suppliers and their subcontractors that are contracted to manufacture Marvell products or related components must (i) adopt a responsible-minerals sourcing policy and perform due diligence on the source and chain of custody of covered minerals to ensure sourcing is consistent with the OECD Guidance or an equivalent recognized framework, and (ii) comply with all applicable contract provisions and Marvell Supplier Code of Conduct. Suppliers must source only from smelters and refiners that have successfully completed an assessment under the Responsible Minerals Initiative’s Responsible Minerals Assurance Process or an equivalent cross-recognized standard.

Suppliers are required to provide documentation, reports, and corrective actions as requested. If a supplier fails to meet these expectations, Marvell will engage as appropriate and may withhold future business.

Marvell monitors global developments and emerging standards related to mineral sourcing in conflict-affected and high-risk areas and beyond, and will evolve its policy and practices in line with these developments.
